17.105 Highways and rights of way

- (a) <u>Parking opposite Trekking Centre</u> B & NES to be contacted again about the 'terrible mess' of vehicles parked opposite the Trekking Centre. Cllr Clarkson had written to Ward Cllr Butters about the matter.
- (b) <u>Wellow Car Park</u> Richard Holland and the Clerk had had a site meeting with Steve Gilbert of B & NES Property Services (report circulated). Mr Gilbert had been thanked for the improvements to the access track. Work to the car park and Station Road had been agreed. It was agreed to hold WPC's Stage Two complaint to see how the work progressed.
- (c) <u>Potholes</u> The Clerk would meet Highways Inspector Nick Sperring the following day to discuss work to potholes, loose cobbles*, fallen tree at the Packhorse Bridge* (if not already cleared) and white lining. Cllrs Andrews and Betts hoped to attend.
- (d) B & NES to be asked to deal with vegetation growing over the path from Wellow Car Park to Canteen Lane. Owners of the stone at the side of the path to be asked to remove it.

17.107 Wellow Playing Field and Playpark

- (a) **RESOLVED to approve** the Service Level Agreement with Wellow Recreation (proposed Cllr Clarkson, 2nd Cllr Andrews, unanimous). A fair copy to be produced for signature. Mike Clarkson was thanked for drawing up the agreement.
- (b) Lyn Doman was thanked for obtaining three quotations to re-fence the west side of the Playing Field (circulated). One quote required amendment to include complete removal of existing fence posts. Provision for the work was not in this year's budget. Mrs Doman offered to put posts in gaps in the fence for the time being.

- (c) <u>Deed of Dedication</u> The Restriction on Title in favour of Sport England was due to be registered at the Land Registry any day. It was agreed the Letter of Intent requested by the contractor should be dealt with once the restriction was in place.
- (d) It was agreed not to erect a 'Tennis' sign opposite the entrance to Wellow Playing Field.
- (e) A tree report to be received in October.
- (e) There was no Playpark update.
