## **Minutes of the Wellow Recreation Trustees Meeting**

#### 1. Apologies & Resignations

Apologies received from Kathryn Black, Giles Pearman, Jonathan Wyld and Debbie Clarkson. The Chair welcomed Sue Chivers as a trustee representing Wellow Parish Council and replaces Cllr Shirley Betts.

## 2. Approve Minutes and Matters Arising

The minutes were approved.

#### 3. Projects

i) Play Park Status

MC reported that work is scheduled to begin on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February and will last up to 6 weeks and will be carried out by the Parish Council's contractor, Sutcliffe Play (South West) Ltd. The play park will be closed to the public and available parking spaces will be restricted to users of the village hall.

#### ii) Flooding

MC reported that recent storms (Ciara and Dennis) have confirmed the nature of the problems caused by flooding on the playing field and Village Hall car park. MC produced a report of 3 problem areas with recommended actions to remedy. (attach report)

#### 4. Finance & Funding

- i) MC presented the income and expenditure reports for the Sports Pavilion and Wellow Recreation together with the latest statement of sports groups contributions. Current Wellow Rec bank balance stands at £6,785.11 including 11,486.81 local play park donations held for the Parish Council.
- ii) Pavilion deficit stands at -£236.35 (to be shared 50/50 with WVT) within budget.

#### 5. Pavilion Status

i) DC reported by email that the Sports Pavilion continues to be well used by the community, with the honesty refreshments scheme also continuing to perform well.

#### 6. Field Management

i) Cricket Nets

MC reported that high winds from Storm Ciara damaged the cricket cages. Despite being tied down to stakes driven into the ground, the strength of the winds and the resistance
